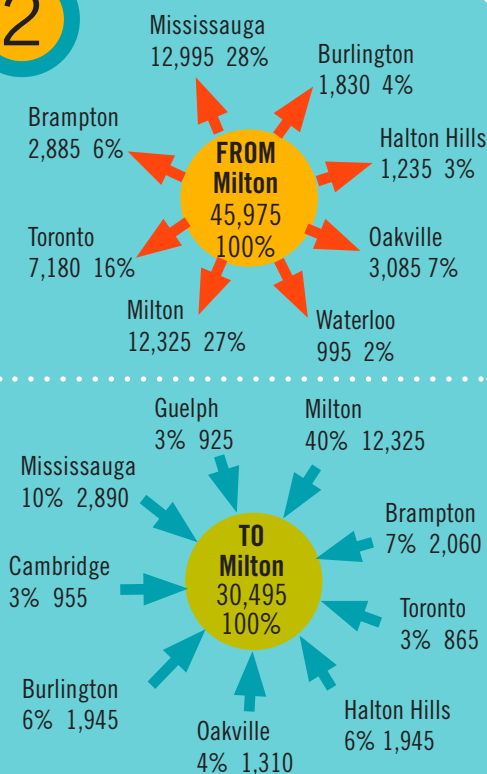

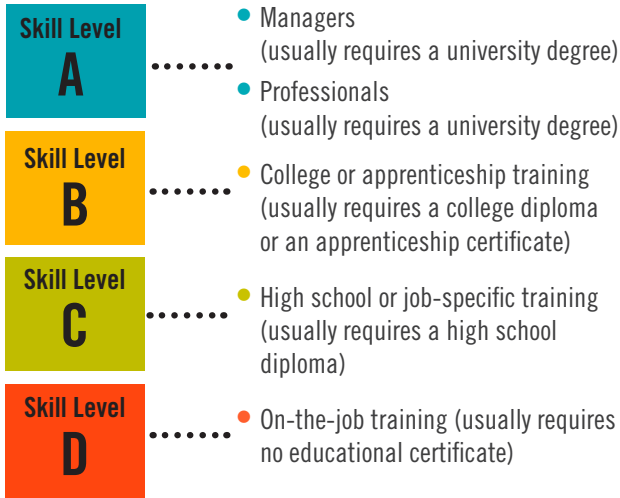

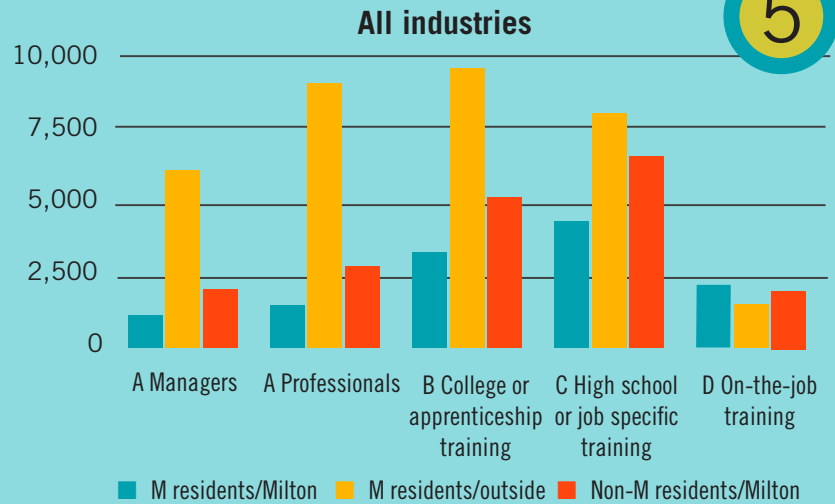

Commuting patterns related to Milton by skill category, All industries, 2016

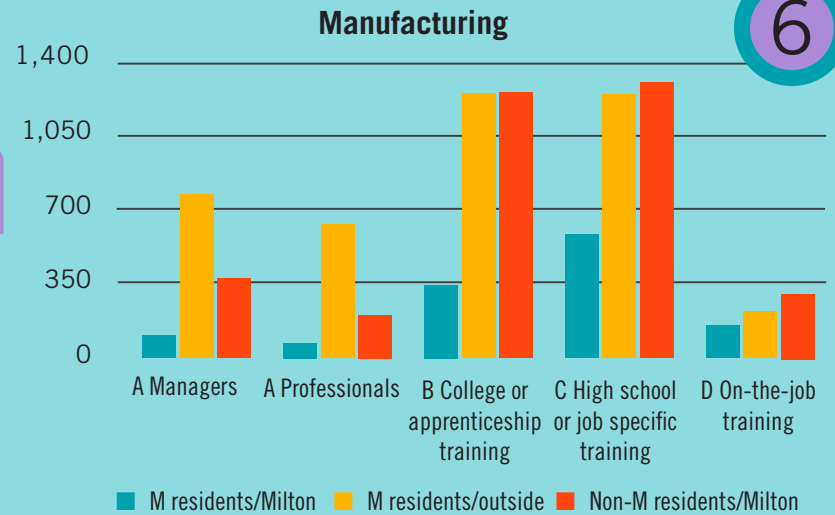


The Milton data has been analyzed by three commuting groups:

- Non-M residents/Milton:** Residents living outside Milton commuting to jobs in Milton

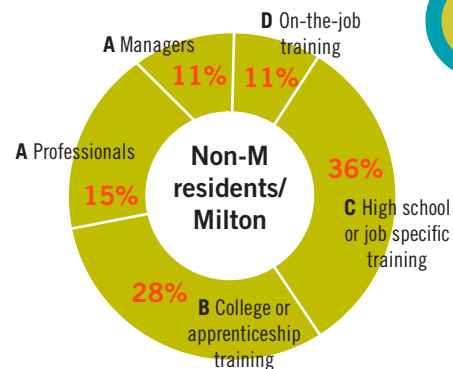
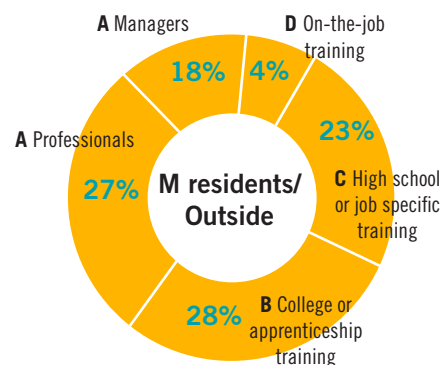
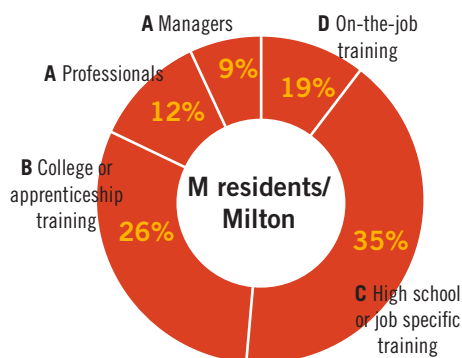


Commuting patterns related to Milton by skill category, Manufacturing, 2016

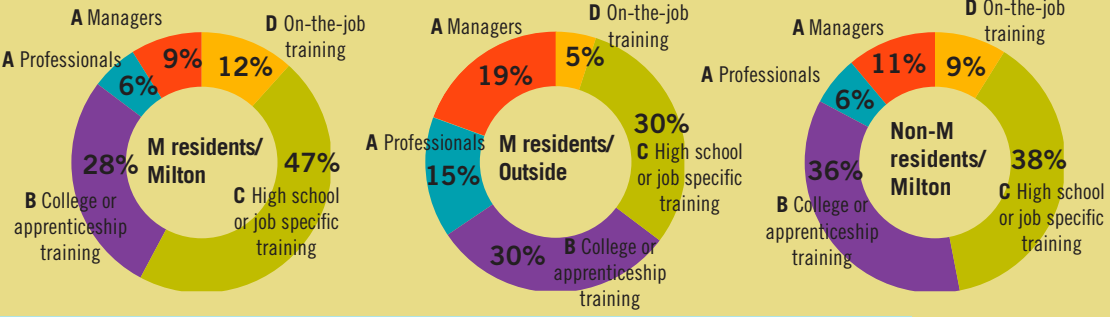

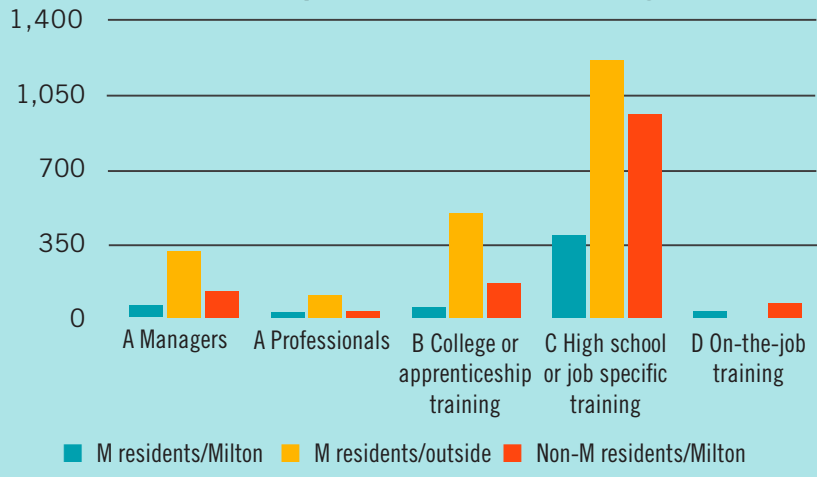

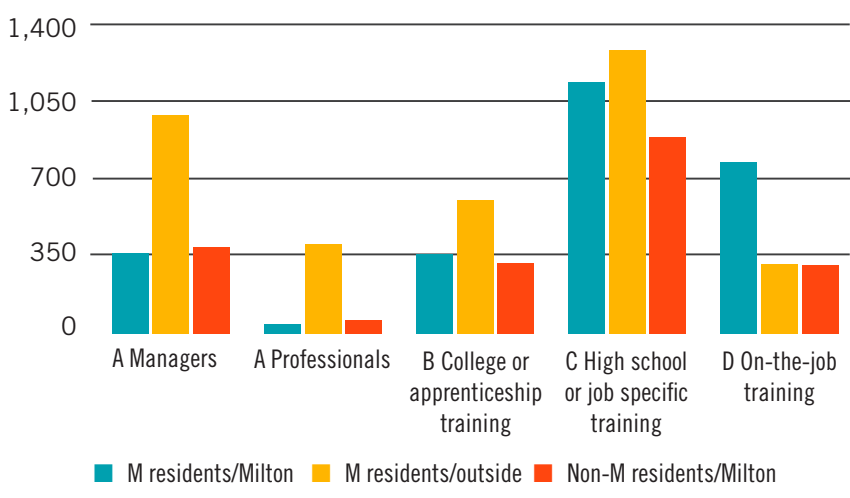

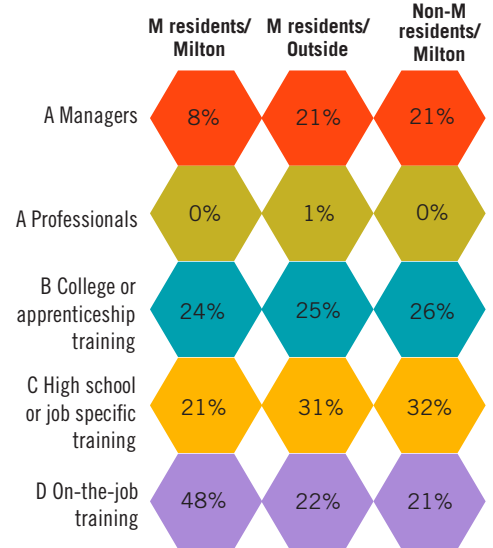
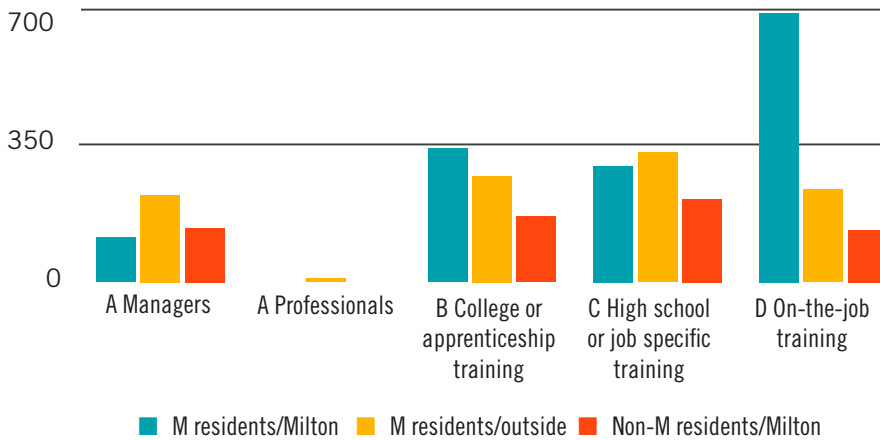

Distribution of skills by Milton commuting populations, Accommodation and food, 2016

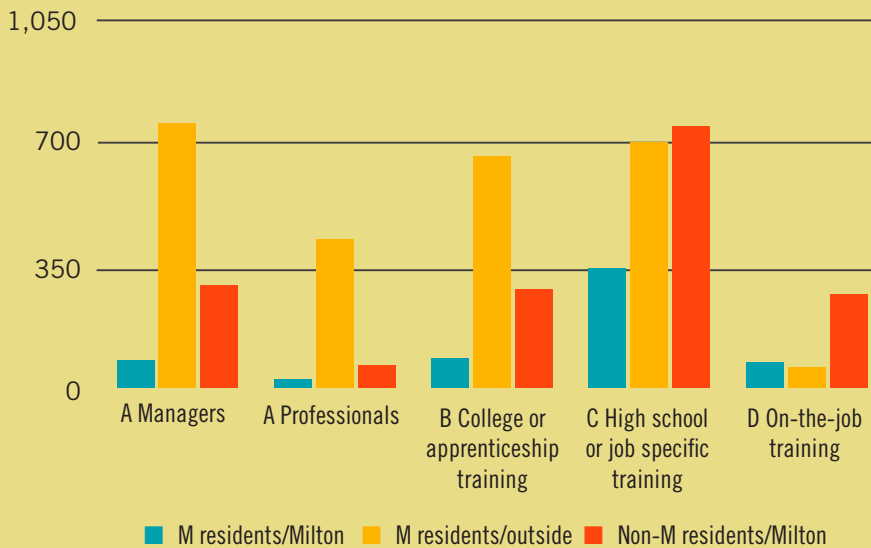

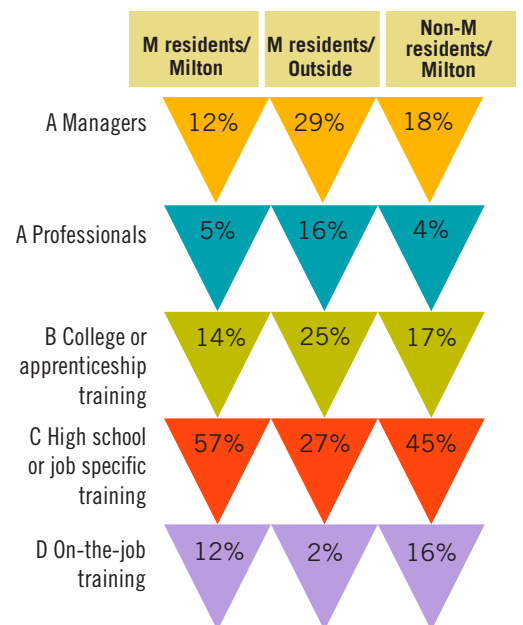
15 Commuting Patterns related to Milton by skill category, Wholesale trade, 2016
