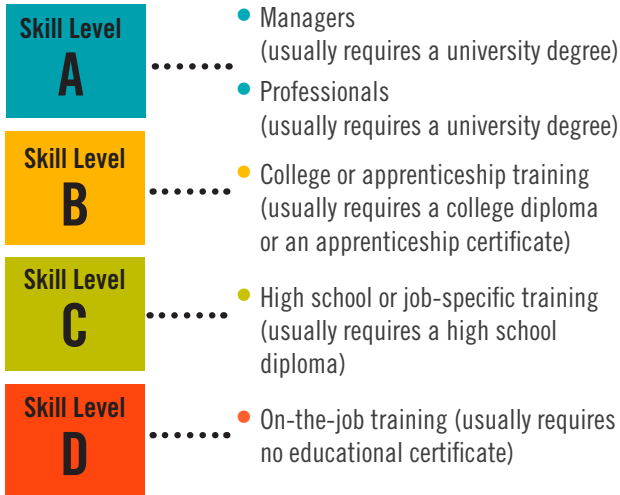

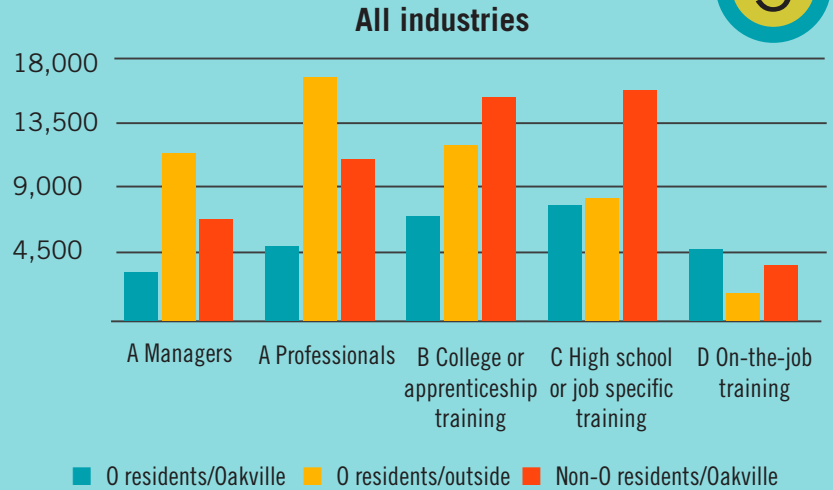

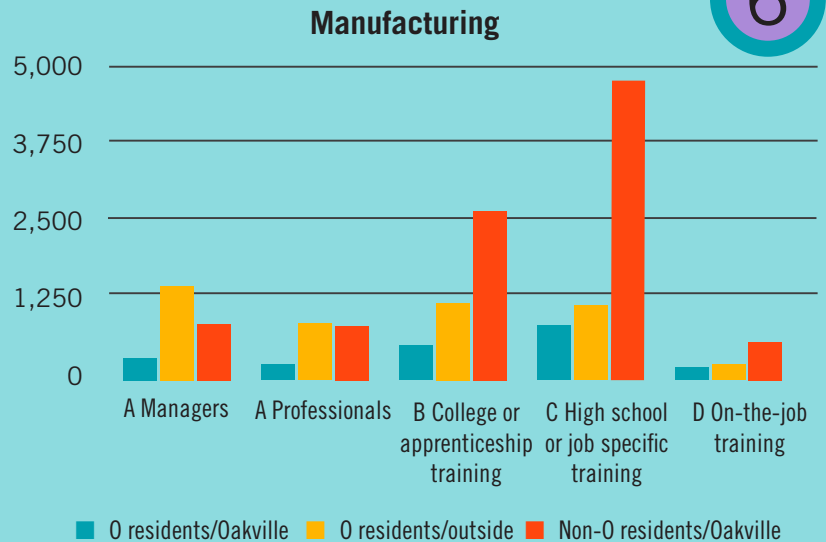

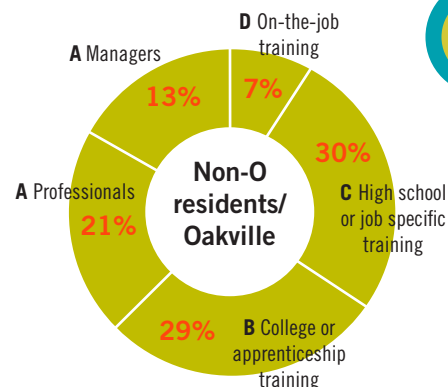
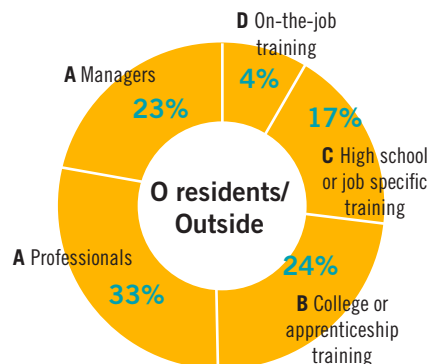
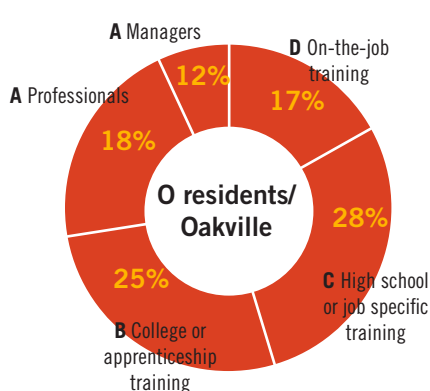
Commuting Patterns related to Oakville by skill category, Manufacturing, 2016

All industries, 2016

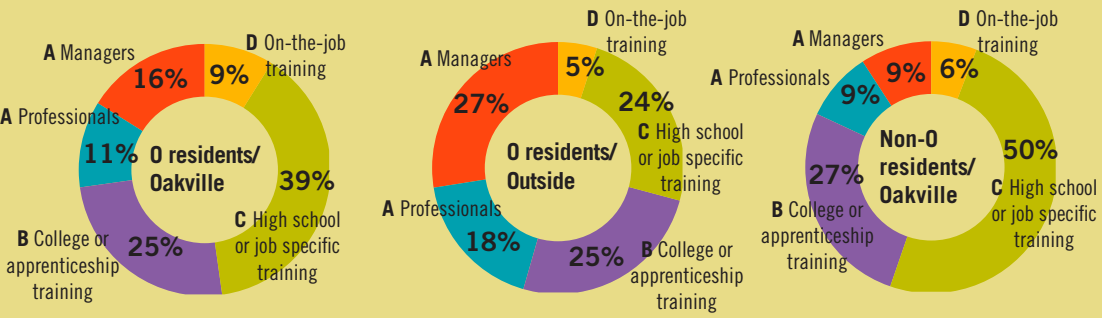

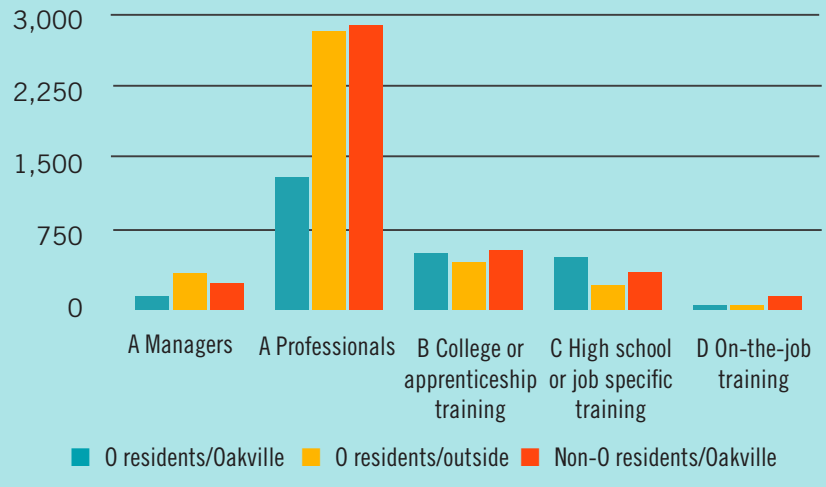

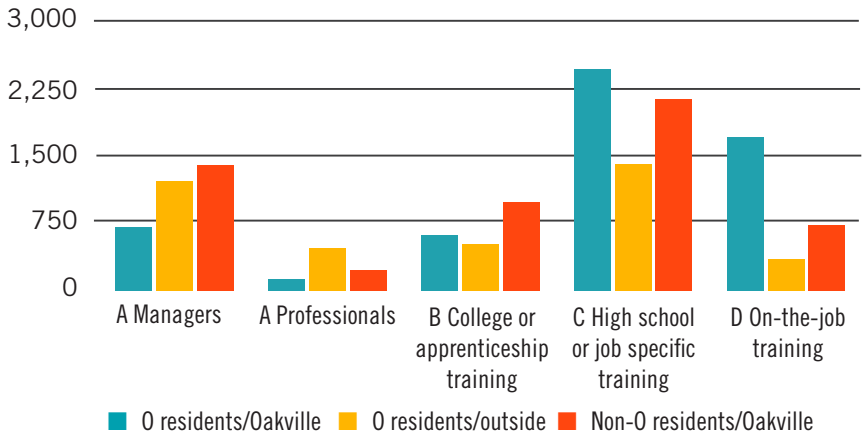

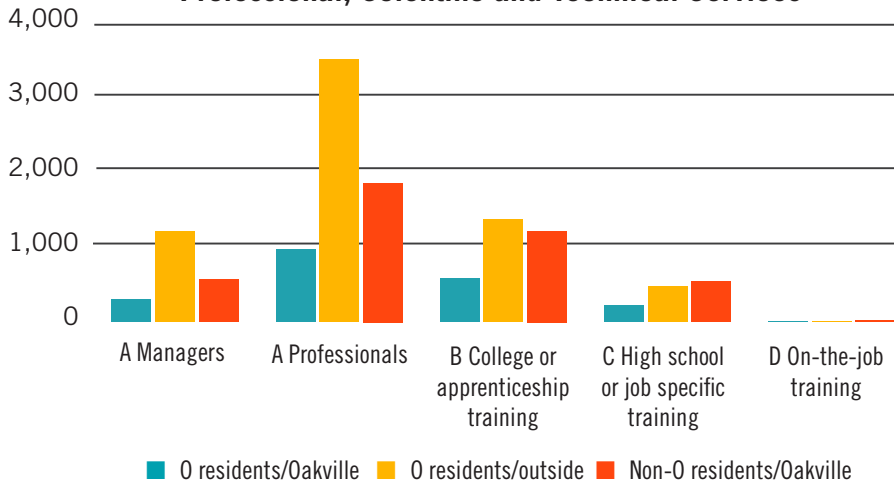

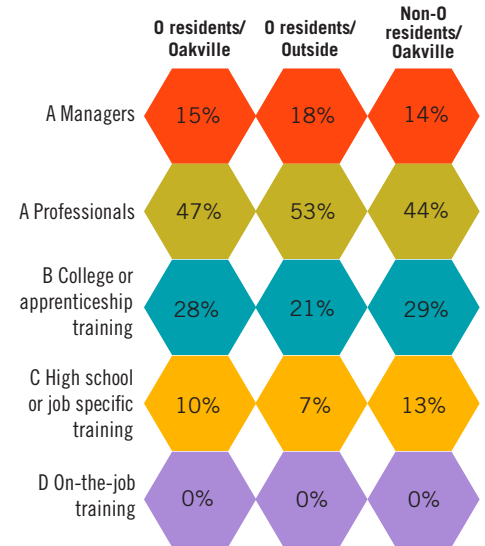
### 13 Commuting Patterns related to Oakville by skill category, Professional, scientific and technical services, 2016

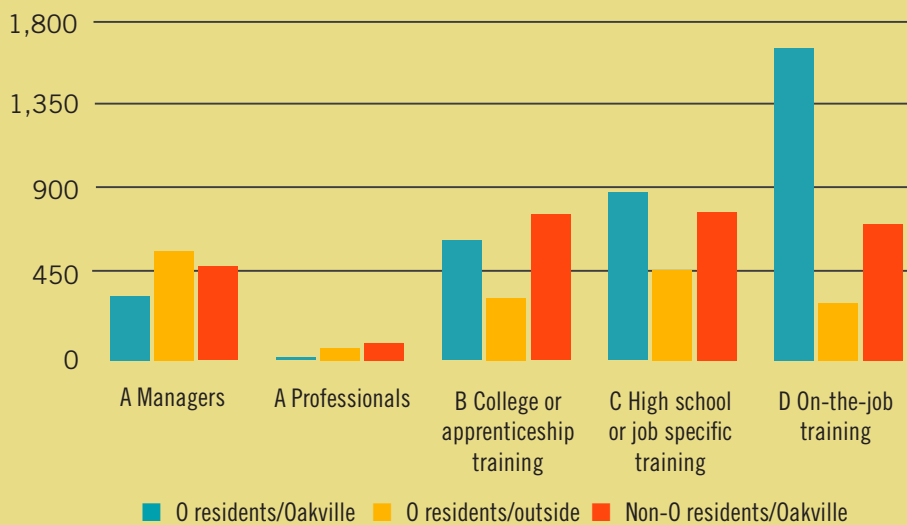

### Distribution of skills by Oakville commuting populations, Professional, scientific and technical services, 2016



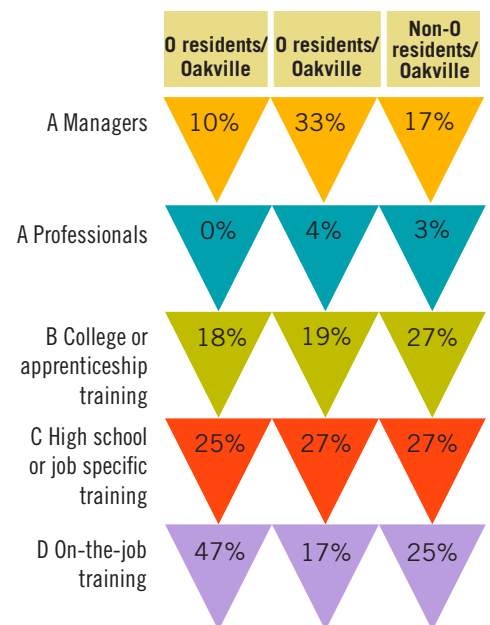
### 15 Commuting Patterns related to Oakville by skill category, Accommodation and Food, 2016
