

# Wage & Training Subsidies for Employers in Peel Halton

Grow and train your workforce- without incurring a large financial burden- through government financial incentives. And since your time is limited, let the more than 30 government-funded service providers in Peel Halton be your no-fee gateway to these wage and training subsidies, helping you with:

- Assistance to fill out applications.
- Hassle-free contract administration and timely payment of financial incentives.
- Access to thousands of qualified job seekers and many other no-fee HR services.

Specific eligibility requirements apply to each grant, so call your local Peel Halton service provider to learn which wage subsidy, tax credit, or training dollars might be available to you.

### 1. HIRE AN UNEMPLOYED JOB SEEKER AND GET A WAGE SUBSIDY

<ul> <li>Program: Employer Hiring Incentive Program</li> <li>Financial Incentive: Up to \$6,000 per employee</li> <li>Submit your job postings and interview pre-screened candidates sent by local employment service providers.</li> </ul>	What you need to do: Contact any one of the service providers listed at the end of this document.
<ul> <li>Ontario Job Creation Partnerships</li> <li>Financial Incentive: Employee salary via El benefits</li> <li>Hire an employee who will be paid via El benefits for up to 52 weeks while you provide new skills and experience.</li> </ul>	What you need to do: Fill out the application for funding, <u>online here.</u> Need help to fill out the form? Contact any one of the service providers listed at the end of this document.

#### 2. TRAIN YOUR CURRENT EMPLOYEES WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF A GRANT

#### Program: Canada-Ontario Job Grant

Financial Incentive: Up to \$10,000 per employee

• Pay one-third of the training costs, delivered by an eligible third-party trainer, to train your staff on the skills they need.

## 3. HIRE YOUTH/NEW GRADUATES AND GET A WAGE SUBSIDY (Ages 15 to 30)

<ul> <li>Program: Skills Link</li> <li>Financial Incentive: Up to \$50,000 for wages and training</li> <li>Hire and train youth for up to 30 weeks. Give them new skills and experience to be able to secure future work.</li> </ul>	What you need to do: <u>Apply online here</u> or submit a hard copy application to Service Canada: 430 Courtneypark Drive East Mississauga, Ontario L5T 2S5
<ul> <li><u>Program: Career Focus</u></li> <li>Financial Incentive: Wage subsidies of up to 50% of participants' wages.</li> <li>Hire a post-secondary graduate for minimum 3 months in a field with a high demand for workers.</li> </ul>	What you need to do: Call your local Service Canada office to learn which local agencies are offering the program. 1-800-622-6232 or <u>search by city/postal code</u> <u>here</u> . Or you can apply directly for your own funding. <u>Click here</u> .
<ul> <li>Program : Youth Employment Program</li> <li>Financial Incentive: Portion of wages, amount to be determined</li> <li>Share a portion of the salary costs to hire post-secondary science, engineering, technology, business or liberal arts graduates. For small or medium-sized companies.</li> </ul>	<b>What you need to do:</b> Contact the Ontario regional office of the Industrial Research Assistance Program (IRAP). 1-877-994-4727.

#### Program : Career Connect

Financial Incentive: Maximum \$13,000

• Hire a graduate for an Information, Communication & Technology position and share in the salary costs. Minimum 3 month term, full-time employment. What you need to do: Apply online here

#### 4. HIRE YOUTH FOR A SUMMER POSITION AND GET A WAGE SUBSIDY (Ages 15 to 30)

NOTE: For summer wage subsidies, employers must access them early each year (January or earlier)

<ul> <li>Program: Summer Jobs Service</li> <li>Financial Incentive: \$2-per-hour, per student</li> <li>Hire a summer student who is returning to school in the fall.</li> </ul>	<b>What you need to do:</b> Call Employment Ontario to learn which local agencies are managing the program. 1-800-387-5656.
<ul> <li>Program: Canada Summer Jobs</li> <li>Financial Incentive: Up to 50% of the provincial minimum wage, per student.</li> <li>Hire a summer student who is returning to school in the fall. For companies with 50 or fewer employees.</li> </ul>	What you need to do: <u>Apply online here</u> or submit completed applications to Service Canada: 430 Courtneypark Drive East Mississauga, Ontario L5T 2S5

#### 5. HIRE A JOB SEEKER WITH A DISABILITY AND GET FINANCIAL INCENTIVES

<ul> <li>Program: Opportunities Fund for Persons with Disabilities</li> <li>Financial Incentive: Wage subsidy; rates vary</li> <li>Diversify your workforce with job-ready employees who are eager to contribute. Ongoing assistance provided to both employer and employee.</li> </ul>	What you need to do: <u>Apply online here</u> or submit completed applications to Service Canada: 4295 King Street East, Kitchener, Ontario N2P 0C6
<ul> <li>Program: Youth the Future</li> <li>Financial Incentive: Wage subsidy for the first 15 weeks of employment at \$11/hour; employer reimbursed for 24 hours of the week</li> <li>Provide minimum 30+ hours of employment per week for candidates who are ready for entry-level positions. Ongoing assistance provided to both employer and employee.</li> </ul>	<b>What you need to do:</b> Contact "Youth the Future" 905-450-1608 x170

#### 6. HIRE AN APPRENTICE AND GET FINANCIAL INCENTIVES

Apprenticeship Job Creation Tax Credit	What you need to do:
Maximum \$2,000 per year, per employee <u>Apprenticeship Training Tax Credit</u>	Contact any one of the service providers listed at the end of this document.
<ul> <li>Maximum credit per apprenticeship \$10,000 per year, over a 48-month period, maximum \$40,000</li> </ul>	
Employer Signing Bonus <ul> <li>\$2,000 per apprentice hired</li> </ul>	
Apprenticeship Completion Employer Bonus <ul> <li>\$1,000 per apprentice who completes his/her apprenticeship</li> </ul>

All financial incentives are based on eligibility requirements as set out by the funders.
